


Model 5612 Doctor's Lower Wall Mount Modules (Shown with left-hand wash station)




Model 5622 Assistant's Lower Wall Mount Modules (Shown with right-hand wash station)




Figure 1. Wall Mounted Lowers




Figure 2. Wall Mounted Uppers




Figure 3. X-ray Wall Insert




Figure 4. Upper Storage Wall Insert




Figure 5. 12 O'Clock Wall Inserts

12-O'Clock Wall Insert

This unit is recessed into a wall and provides space for installation of a wall mounted delivery system.

Optional Push-Open Door (Only on 42" insert)

Provides easy access to stored materials. To open, lightly press in on the door, the latch will release and the door will open. To close, give the door a gentle push. Refer to page 15 for door hinge adjustment instructions.




Figure 6. Models 5661/34 with Accessory Panel

Accessory Panel

Accessory panel provides area for integration of control panels for analgesia or other specified accessories.

12-O'Clock Wall Insert This unit is recessed into a wall and provides space for installation of a wall mounted delivery system.

Water Temperature Adjustment




Figure 7. Adjusting the Faucet

Wall Mount Doctor's and Assistant's wash stations are equipped with a manually adjusted faucet. An optional Foot Activated Water Control dispenses cold water and a mixture of hot/cold (tepid) water. The temperature of the tepid mix is determined by the setting of the faucet handle (see Figure 7).

To set the water temperature of the Foot Activated Water Control, press the tepid-water foot disc, then move the faucet handle until the water is at the desired temperature. The water will maintain this setting until the faucet handle is moved. Note that if the faucet is set so that only cold water flows from the faucet, the toe-plate for hot/cold mix will yield only cold water and that if the faucet is set so that only hot water flows from the faucet, the cold water toe-plate will not dispense any water.

Filling the Soap Dispenser

The soap dispenser can be easily filled above the countertop, without removing the bottle.




Figure 8. Refilling the Soap Dispenser

To fill the soap dispenser, pull the head and pump assembly away from the bottle, then fill the bottle with liquid soap (see Figure 8). When finished, replace the head and pump assembly.

Replacing Color End Caps

The replaceable color end caps are mounted to your dental furniture with Phillips-head screws.




Figure 9. Replacing Color End Caps

To remove an end cap, clear the shelves of the unit to provide easy access to the mounting screws located on the interior of your dental furniture (see Figure 9).

Caution

When removing or replacing end caps on lower units you will need someone to support the end cap to prevent it from falling off the unit when the screws are removed.

Remove the plastic screw caps covering the screws (located in the uppers and in the lower equipment end) by gripping the cap firmly and pulling. Remove the screws, allowing the end cap to be lifted off the unit.

To replace the end cap, position the end cap over the screw holes, install the screws and replace the screw caps.

Wooden Door Removal

For convenient door removal and replacement, wooden doors and lead lined x-ray doors utilize quick-release hinges.




Figure 10. Removing Wooden Doors

To remove wooden doors (see Figure 10), press in on the locking tab, then unlatch the hinge.




Figure 11 Reinstalling Wooden Doors

To reinstall the doors, align the pin in the hinge into the front of the mounting plate (see Figure 11), then snap the latch in place. Swing the door back and forth several times to be sure the hinge is secure.

Wooden Door Hinge Adjustments

Door hinges should be adjusted during installation. Adjustment screws on each hinge allow you to readjust the hinges if it becomes necessary.




Figure 12. Adjusting Wooden Doors

To adjust hinges for wooden doors (see Figure 12):

Depth: Loosen screw **A** one full turn, then move the door in or out until it fits properly. Retighten the screw.

Height: Loosen screws **B** in both hinges one quarter turn, then move the door up or down until it fits properly. Retighten the screws.

Side-to-Side: Loosen or tighten screw C until the door fits properly.

When you have completed the adjustment, swing the door in and out a few times to be sure it operates properly.

Glass Door Adjustment

Caution

To avoid injury, make sure the hinge screws are firmly tightened after adjusting the glass doors.




Figure 13. Adjusting Glass Doors

To adjust glass doors, slightly loosen the adjustment screw at each hinge (see Figure 13). Move the door until it fits properly, then retighten the screws.

Drawer Push Latch Adjustment

To adjust the drawer push latches (see Figure 14), remove the pin from the barrel of the push latch. Adjust the barrel by turning it counterclockwise (out) or clockwise (in) until the front of the drawer is flush with the unit. Replace the pin in the barrel.




Figure 19. Adjusting Drawer Push Latch

X-Ray Bi-Fold Door Roller Adjustment




Figure 15. Adjusting X-ray Bi-fold Door Roller

To adjust the x-ray bi-fold door roller (see Figure 15), move the door until the top part of the roller assembly lines up with the bottom part of the roller assembly. Using a Phillips screwdriver, tighten the roller assembly adjustment screw until it is flush with the base of the roller assembly and the door is square with the x-ray bi-fold case.


